tons of concrete and 11,000 tons of steel.

Noon Walk to a group lunch at Jamie's Italian along the Thames

Day 4 | Wednesday, May 22 (London)

Early Morning Stop by Big Ben and the British Parliament, two iconic London structures

Late Morning Attend a company visit at Atkins

Early Afternoon Group lunch nearby

Late Afternoon Embark on the London Underground and Tube Tour

Learn about the Tube's origin, design and construction. Begin at the Sherlock Holmes statue by Baker Street Station, visit an old ghost station that has been abandoned for over 50 years, and finish at the futuristic Westminster Station.

the Roman Baths on your own

Bath is a breathtaking town that features elegant Georgian squares. It was the

favorite destination of Queen Victoria, Lord Nelson, and Jane Austen.

Late Afternoon Free time in Bath for exploration and small group dinners **Evening** Bus to Nottingham (~3 hours) and check into your hotel

Day 8 | Sunday, May 26 (Nottingham)

Visit Peak District National Park for hiking or cycling (~1 hour bus from hotel) Morning

> Explore the spectacular countryside of Peak District by bicycle on bridleways, quiet lanes and traffic-free trails. Lovely villages, superb views, interesting history, fascinating wildlife and geology — it's all in Peak District for you to enjoy. This guided cycling activity is optional; you may also choose to hike or

simply relax in the park.

Return to the hotel; free time to explore Nottingham Afternoon/Evening

Day 9 | Monday, May 27 (Nottingham to Liverpool)

Check out of the hotel and head to the University of Nottingham for cultural Morning

exchange activities

Tour the campus with local students and attend a guest lecture covering some

of England's most significant engineering projects.

Group lunch with local students on campus Noon

Bus to JCB Excavators (~50 min) for a private tour of manufacturing facilities **Early Afternoon**

> Our visit will begin with welcome refreshments and a short presentation showcasing JCB's global manufacturing facilities and products. We'll then continue onto the assembly line of the world famous Backhoe Loader machine. Here we'll see how the machine is built from sheet steel, profiling, laser cutting,

welding, painting, and assembling.

Continue along the road to Liverpool (~1 hour 50 min) **Late Afternoon**

This personalized tour of Ireland's most prestigious university will provide insight into students' daily life and education. The visit is arranged in

Evening Free time to explore Dublin; small group dinners on your own

Day 12 | Thursday, May 30 (Dublin to Galway)

Morning Check out of the hotel and board a train to Galway (~2.5 hours)

Enjoy this morning's train ride through the Irish countryside en route to Galway, the cultural and artistic capital of the west of Ireland, as well as one of the best

places to listen to traditional Irish music.

Early Afternoon Check into your hotel, followed by free time and small group lunches on your

own in Eyre Square

Late Afternoon Attend a company visit at Boston Scientific

Evening Free time to explore Galway and small group dinners on your own

Morning Visit the Cliffs of Moher (~1.5 hours by bus from hotel)
