1:00 PM Small group lunches on your own at the Fazer Visitor's Center2:45 PM Board the ferry to Suomenlinna and enjoy a guided walking tour

The Suomenlinna Sea Fortress is a UNESCO World Heritage Site situated across an eight-island archipelago. Constructed as a maritime base during the Swedish occupation and later seized by Russian forces during the Russo- Swedish war,

the area was eventually reclaimed by the Finnish government in 1918.

3:00 PM Embark on a walking tour of central Oslo

waterfront area before visiting Oslo City Hall.

Built on the edge of a fjord, this spectacular structure won the European Prize for Contemporary Architecture in 2009. A climb up the unique sloping roof

reveals panoramic views of Oslo.

Founded in 2015, No Isolation is a young Norwegian company that aims to reduce social isolation for vulnerable students and seniors with the help of

 2:30 PM Visit the Cambi-designed Romerike Biogas Plant

This government-funded waste management center processes up to 50,000 tons of household food and industrial waste per year, producing the biofertilizer and biogas that fuel Oslo's farms and transportation systems. Consider wearing

a mask as this interesting plant produces an unpleasantly strong stench!

Located approximately 60 miles south of Oslo on Norway's sunny southeastern coast, this shoreside town was once a base for the Royal Norwegian Navy in the 18th and 19th centuries. Its long history can be seen reflected in an array of Viking burial mounds and other local cultural relics from the Stone Age and

Viking Period.
